<u>City of Unalaska Legislative Report</u> <u>1/26/25</u>

The first week of the 34th Alaska State Legislature proved to be an eventful one, as both chambers successfully organized themselves on the initial day—a significant achievement not seen since 2017. Senator Gary Stevens resumes his role as Senate President, heading a bipartisan majority comprising 14 members. In the House, Representative Edgmon of Dillingham was elected Speaker on Tuesday, leading a coalition of 21 members from across the political spectrum. Individuals interested in the House committee assignments can find them <u>here</u>.

A noteworthy aspect of the week was the introduction of 116 bills and six constitutional amendments across both legislative bodies, including pre-filed measures, indicating key legislative priorities. The focus areas being discussed for the 34th Legislature include education, public employee and teacher retirement, energy, enhancements to the electoral processes, and improvements to state budgeting structures. The Senate Resources Committee, under the chairmanship of Senator Giessel, convened on Wednesday for a briefing on Cook Inlet Gas, featuring insights from industry professionals from Furie and Hilcorp. A link to the video recording of this meeting can be found <u>here</u>.

Additionally, on Thursday, the House Transportation Committee, led by Representative Carrick, received updates from two local transportation planning organizations regarding the Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP) and future projections.
