- VII. Old or Unfinished Business
  - A. Library Building Improvement Project City Librarian presented the results of the recent Library Project Survey and several draft floor plans. Architects and engineers from ECI will be on the island February 11-14 to talk with the public, library staff, and City Council about developing plans. There will be a public meeting Monday, 2/11, at 6:30 PM and an open house Wednesday, 2/13, from 4:30 – 7:00 PM. There will also be focus group meetings with story time parents and local organizations that present lectures, classes and workshops for the community.
  - B. Annual Report to City Council City Librarian presented final draft of the annual report for the committee's review. The Committee Chair will present the report at the Council meeting on 2/12/19.
  - C. On-Call Staff This project is advancing through City Administration channels and has the support of the City Manager, though it has not been approved by City Council yet.

  - A. Election of Officers Hanson-Zueger nominated Crane as Committee Chair. Hatfield seconded. Crane nominated Thompson as Committee Chair, and Hatfield seconded. Passed by voice vote.
  - B. Library Cards In approximately two years, the current library card supply will run out. This will coincide with the opening of the expanded building, and the Committee supported the idea of a new library card design to

celebrate the expansion. Committee will think about ideas for selecting a new design over the next few months.
